### **History of July 21**

- ♦ 1962: There was a war on the border between India and China.

### **Current Affairs Related to 21 July**

- Kotak Mahindra Bank completes integration with new tax portal. One of the first private banks to be fully integrated with the new portal has announced the completion of its technical integration with the filing system. Kotak Mahindra Bank customers can now pay their direct taxes online through the portal's e-pay tax page, using Kotak Net Banking or in person at a branch, according to a statement from the lender. It will make the tax payment process quick, easy and convenient for its customers.
- An agreement was signed between the Reserve Bank of India and Bank Indonesia to enhance cooperation in payment systems, digital financial innovation, anti-money laundering and countering the financing of terrorism. During the G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors meeting in Bali, the two central banks agreed on a memorandum of understanding to advance mutual cooperation.
- VK Singh has taken over as the Director of REC Ltd. Prior to this promotion VK Singh was Executive Director at REC and holds a portfolio of key business areas including Private Sector Project Management, Unit Appraisal and Procurement and is also a Director on the Board of REC Power Development & Consultancy Limited.
- ♦ Veteran sports administrator Narinder Batra has resigned as the President of the Indian Olympic Association, International Hockey Federation, as well as a member of the International Olympic Committee, citing personal reasons. Mr Batra ceased to be the President of the Indian Olympic Association when the Delhi High Court on 25 May annulled the post of Life Member in Hockey India, courtesy of IOA Contested elections and won back in 2017.
- Mexico has topped the Expat Insider Ranking for 2022, which was recently released by The International, while India is ranked 36th out of 52 countries on the list with a high affordability score.

- Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute and Research Center New Delhi has commissioned the first ever Made-in-India Surgical Robotic System, SSI Mantra, by SS Innovation, a new age Indian med-tech startup. Simple SSI Mantra, the brainchild of world renowned robotic cardiac surgeon Dr Sudhir P Srivastava, will herald the beginning of a new era of surgical procedures in India, making robotic surgery accessible and affordable to the people of our country.
- INS Sindhudhwaj has been decommissioned after 35 years of illustrious service to the nation. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Vice Admiral Biswajit Dasgupta, Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command. The submarine crest depicts a gray nurse shark and the name means flag bearer at sea. Sindhudhwaj, as the name suggests, was the flag bearer of indigenization and is a Russian-built Sindhughosh class submarine that has been involved in the Indian Navy's journey to self-reliance.
- ♦ OneCard a mobile-first credit card company raised \$100 million in a Series D round of funding backed by Temasek, making it the 104th Unicorn in India. India has created more than 20 financial unicorns so far in 2022, including OneCard, Open, Oxyzo, and Yubi.
- ♦ The Department of Consumer Affairs has constituted a committee under Additional Secretary Nidhi Khanni in an effort to provide a holistic framework for Right to Repair.
- Conference started in Bangladesh. Indian delegation led by DG, BSF Pankaj Singh reached Dhaka for the 52nd BGB-BSF Director General Level Border Conference in Bangladesh. On the first day, various topics including border management, drug smuggling, arms and ammunition smuggling, trafficking of women and children and other development initiatives within 150 yards of the International Border were discussed.


